

Valda Quick Biennial Paper Arts Exhibition 2010 Conditions of Entry

Works, Sales, and Photography

1. All exhibits must be original in concept and design.
2. All participants must be members of Papermakers of Victoria Inc.
3. Works submitted should not predate 2008
4. \$10 exhibiting fee per artist/group to accompany entry form (covers up to six pieces)
5. Work may be for sale, no commission will be taken on sales
6. Works are to be entered in one of four categories:- 2D wall pieces; Books and stationery; 3D works and miniature books
7. There is a limit of 1 m in any direction on the size of all works, 2D or 3D works are acceptable. Miniature books must be less than 10cm in all directions. Collaborative works are acceptable as long as both/all collaborators are members of Papermakers of Victoria. Collaborative works can be in addition to the maximum allowed.
8. All exhibits must be clearly labeled with the category, title, name and address of the exhibitor. Work may be for sale.
9. All works, where applicable, must be properly mounted and ready for hanging or display. Clear instructions for hanging or any special requirements for display should be given if required.
10. Papermakers of Victoria will make a photographic record of the exhibition. These photographs may be used for publicity purposes.
11. The Exhibition Committee does not accept any responsibility or liability for any damage or loss or theft of any exhibit arising from any cause including negligence. Accordingly exhibitors are strongly advised to undertake their own insurance.
12. Each participant or group can enter up to six pieces with no more than three in each category. A form should be submitted for each piece, please copy the form for each exhibit and keep a copy for your records.
13. The Exhibition Committee reserves the right to consider, but not necessarily exhibit, all works submitted. No correspondence will be entered into.
14. Small works may be exhibited in display cabinets.

Exhibition Delivery and Return

19. Exhibits must be delivered to: Papermakers of Victoria meeting at Box Hill Community Arts Centre, 470 Station Street, Box Hill on Saturday, 9 October between 1 pm and 4pm or to 11 Keltie Street, Glen Iris between 10am and 12 noon on Friday 16 October 2010.

20. Any posted or couriered entries must arrive at 11 Keltie Street, Glen Iris by 11 October 2010. If work is mailed or couriered please enclose a stamped, self addressed envelope or prepaid courier slip for return of work.
21. Any other methods for return of work must be prearranged with the exhibition committee before the work is delivered for exhibition.
22. Exhibits must be collected on Sunday 21 November, between 4 & 5 pm from Bundoora Homestead Gallery or on Monday 22 November between 10am and 12 noon from 11 Keltie Street, Glen Iris.
23. Prepaid mail or couriered work will be returned after the exhibition closes.
